Greg Cane
Head Coach



Cane officially became the first head soccer coach in Bulldog history in 1994, and has paced the sideline for each of the team's 427 matches during the program's 24-year existence. During that time, the Duluth native has won at a .612 clip, piling up an overall record of 241-145-41.

During his tenure, Cane has had 77 All-NSIC Team members, three NSIC Offensive Players of the Year, as well as two NSIC Defensive Players of the Year. UMD has also had 13 Scholar All-Americans, in addition to two All-Americans. The Bulldogs have clamied the NSIC league crown five times (1997, 1998, 2001-03) as well as five conference tournament titles (1997, 1998, 2001, 2003, and 2009) in 16 seasons of NSIC competition. Cane has twice led UMD to unblemished conference marks (1997 and 2003) and both teams been named the NSIC Coach of the Year. An NCAA Elite Eight run in 2013 by UMD also led to a year end rank of seventh by the NSCAA.



Kelly Grgas-Wheeler
Assistant Coach

The longest-serving UMD assistant in program history, Grgas-Wheeler joined the Bulldog staff in 2004 with four years of previous high-level collegiate coaching experience tucked under her belt. That included a two-season assistant stint at NCAA Division-I University of Texas El Paso. Before accepting the UTEP post, Grgas-Wheeler was an assistant coach at Cochise College (Ariz.) for two years. Grgas-Wheeler, who earned her NSCAA National Diploma in June of 2007, has spent 18 years as a head coach in the Gitch Gummi Soccer Club.

Insurance and Medical Treatment

All campers must have medical insurance. You must register online or complete the enrollment form on the far right column of this page in full including all medical and insurance information. By signing the Consent for Participation and Medical Information form, you acknowledge the inherent risk of injury by participation. An injury can range from minor injury to a major injury. Such injuries could cause permanent disability such as paralysis, permanent bone or joint injury, permanent scars, other chronic disabling conditions, and even death. If your son or daughter experiences a minor injury, first aid will be provided. For a major injury, an ambulance will be summoned to transport your daughter to a hospital.

Meals

For those camps which include meals, meals are provided by UMD Food Service in the Residence Hall Dining Center or by local restuarants in an alternate dining area, including one evening where there will be a pizza night.

Housing

All overnight campers will be housed, one or two to a room, in a university residence hall. There are no accommodations for a three person room. Housing Staff and Superviors will include coaches staying in the dorm for the duration of each camp. If you are requesting a roommate, BOTH you and your preferred roommate must request one another on your online enrollment forms or on your mailed in registration forms.

Cancelation Policy

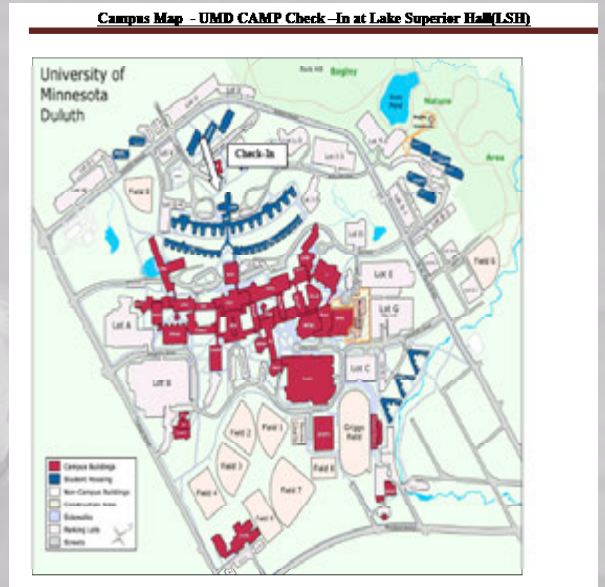
